The Tasmanian Conservation Trust is concerned that two EPBC listed species (*Litoria raniformis* green and gold frog (vulnerable) and *Engaeus granulatus* central north burrowing crayfish (endangered) are likely to be impacted by the construction of proposed Sassafras Wesley Vale Water Pipeline and the proponent has failed to provide evidence to substantiate claims these impacts can be avoided.

Section 3, pages 7 and 8 of the 'Referral of Proposed Act Form' states in relation to both species they:

May be impacted upon by the pipeline construction (some habitat may be impacted upon, but the species is known to recolonise areas post-soil and vegetation disturbance) and post-commissioning impacts to be controlled by property and landscape level planning measures.

Section 4, page 5, of the 'Referral of Proposed Act Form' states that:

Measures have been developed and integrated into a 'Construction Environmental Management Plan' to ensure that impacts to listed species are avoided.

The proponent has failed to provide the 'Construction Environmental Management Plan' with their referral documents and we can not find any description of the proposed avoidance measures nor evidence supporting them.

These species appear to be the only matters of national significant which are potentially impacted by the pipeline and their claims should be substantiated. Given the species' biology it is likely that avoidance strategies can be developed and successfully implemented, but it is vital we have a chance to review the strategy and comment on it. We believe the Australian Government should insist on the proponent providing this evidence and releasing it for the public to comment.
