Dorset EDG Dairy Plan flawed and unviable

Tasmania's peak conservation group has today labelled the Dorset EDG proposal for a massive increase in dairy production in Tasmania's northeast, as highlighted in yesterday's Examiner, as flawed and unviable.

TCT Director Craig Woodfield says that the whole proposal is predicated on a series of decade-old dam proposals that are unviable, and in most cases, unbuildable.

"What we are seeing here is a classic Tasmanian strategy – flogging a dead horse. Rather than look for new and innovate ways of dealing with the State Government-induced crisis in the northeast, the Dorset EDG has dragged out something that has already failed to work."

Mr. Woodfield said that any attempt to railroad these dam proposals through the system would result in a bitter and protracted fight with the conservation movement.
